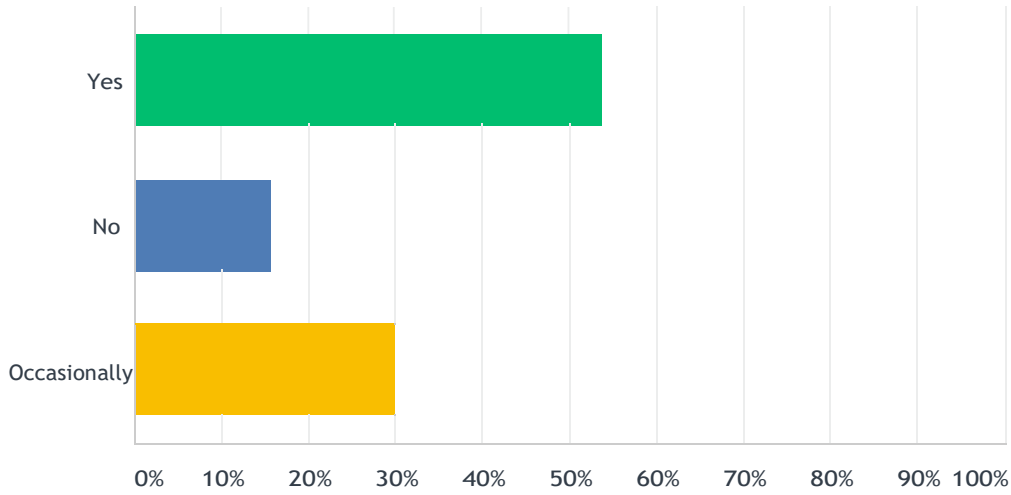


### Q1 Do you watch our online services regularly?

Likes: Music, comfort of seeing the service in a familiar format, flexibility to view recorded services at any time, the pictures, seeing familiar faces

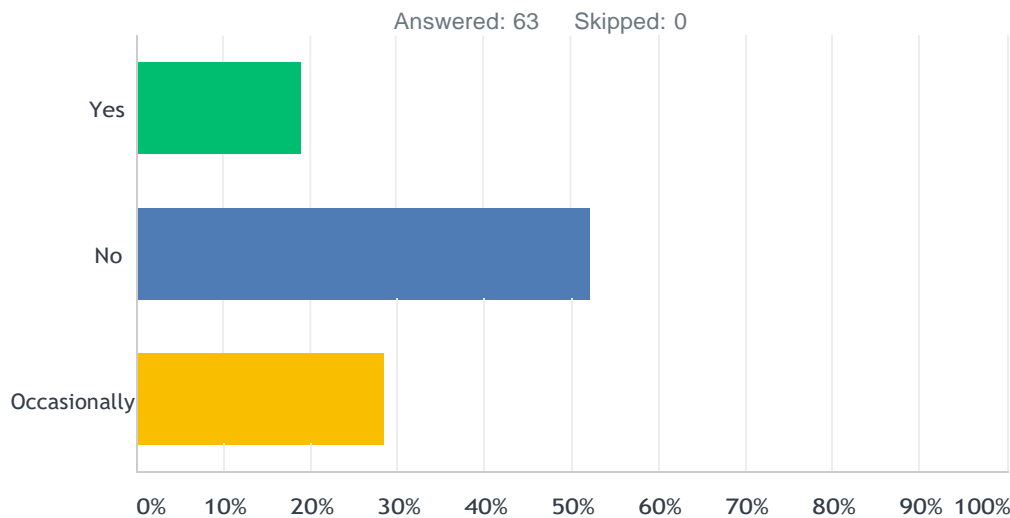
## Q3 If you answered "no" to the question above, please let us know why you opt out from viewing.

### Q6 What other types of virtual gatherings would you participate in/like to see? (i.e., vespers services, panel discussions, etc.)?

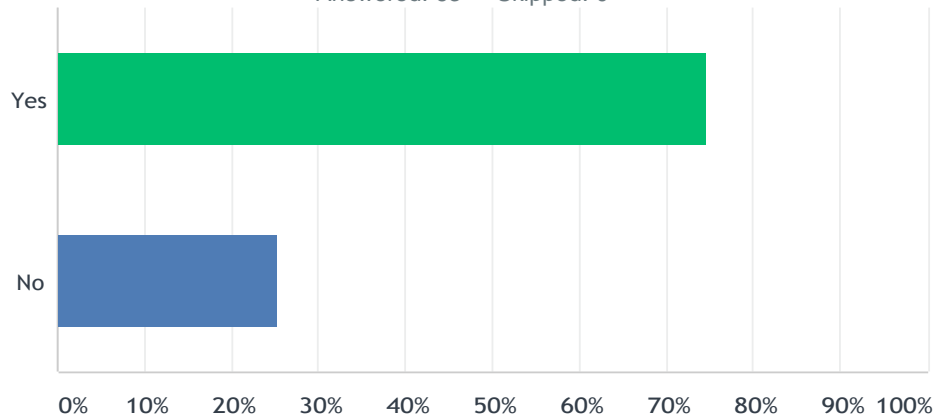

### Q7 When we resume live services, would you like to have them made available online?

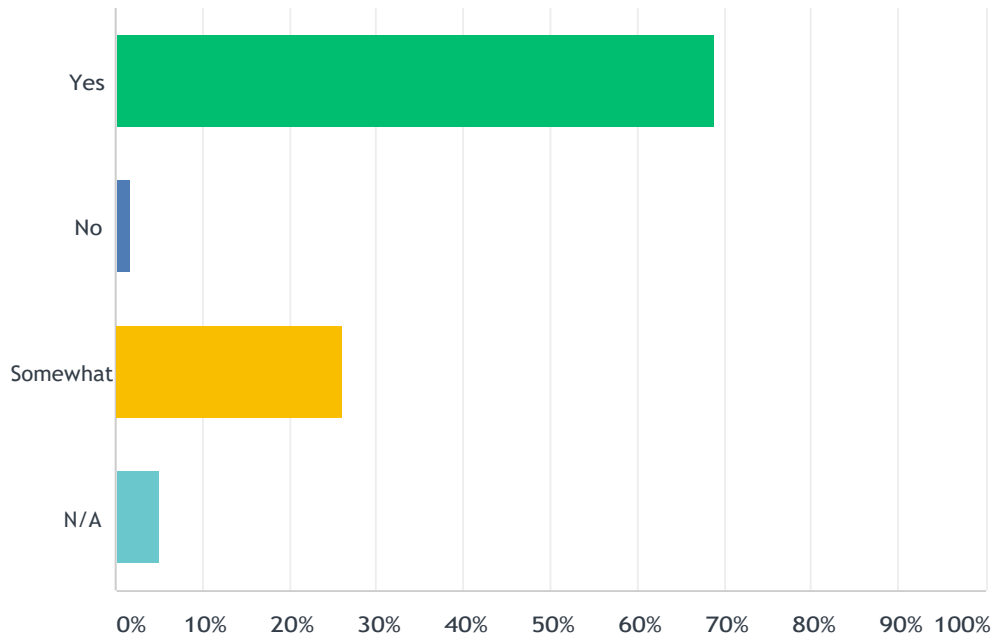

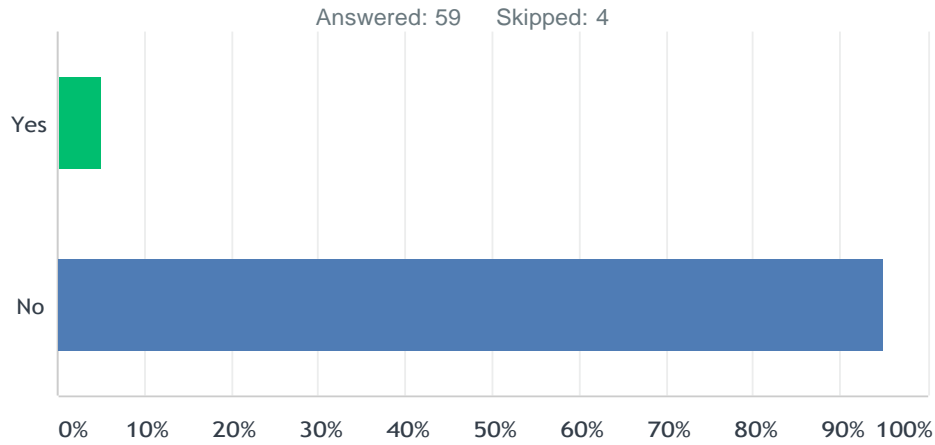
## Q12 Is there any information included in Tidings that you think is not needed?

### Q13 Would you be interested in joining the Stewardship Committee?



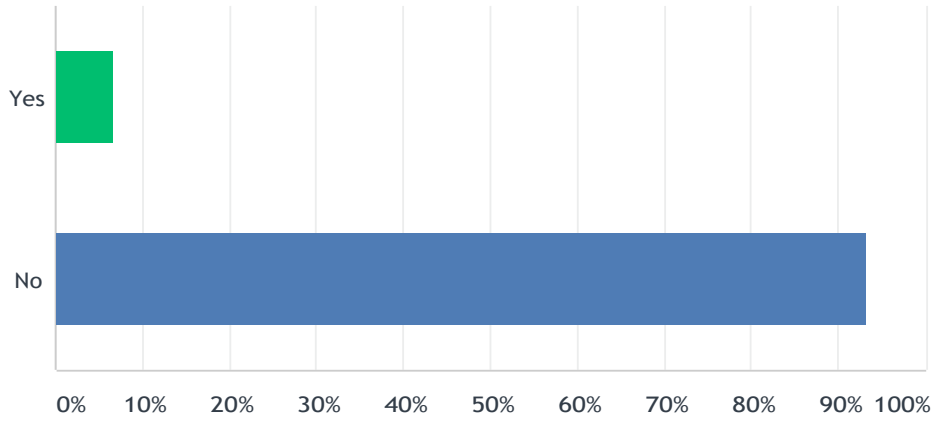

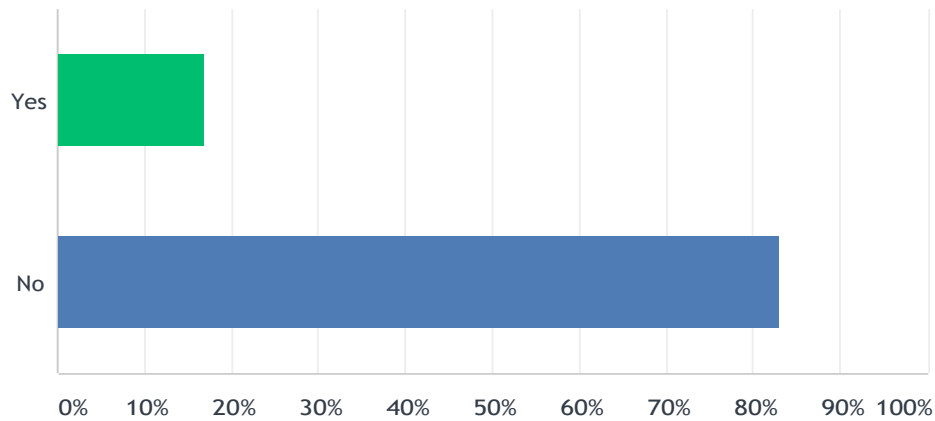
